Classes are intentionally designed for young children between the ages of infant and 4 years old. With regular attendance and attentive adult support, young children will find opportunities to master key developmental milestones in every domain.

**Enrollment:** This is a drop-in program, but enrollment forms must be on file for each child in attendance.

**Supervision:** HPNC's Play N Learn Program is a great way for adults to socialize with one another. Even when you are chatting, however, every child must always be supervised (max adult: child ratio 1:3).
