Play-N-Learn classes at HPNC provide opportunity for young children and their caregivers to enjoy one another's company while participating in a combination of informal playgroups and semi-structured learning activities. Classes are intentionally designed for young children between the ages of infant and 4 years old. With regular attendance and attentive adult support, young children will find opportunities to master key developmental milestones in every domain.

Enrollment: This is a drop-in program, but enrollment forms must be on file for each child in attendance.

Supervision: HPNC's Play N Learn Program is a great way for adults to socialize with one another. Even when you are chatting, however, every child must always be supervised (max adult: child ratio1:3).
